

**Brief CV of Dr Henry HL Chan**  
**M.B.B.S. (Lond), MD (Lond), PhD (HK),**  
**MRCP (UK), FRCP (Lond), FRCP (Edin), FRCP RCPS (Glasg),**  
**FHKCP, FHKAM (Medicine)**

Dr Henry Chan is a private dermatologist. He is also currently the Honorary Clinical Professor, Department of Medicine, The University of Hong Kong and the research staff of the Wellman Center for Photomedicine, Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston, USA. He was the President of the Hong Kong College of Dermatologists (2009 – 2013) and the Honorary Secretary of the Asian Dermatological Association (1999 – 2011). He was also the Chairman of the Hong Kong Society of Dermatology and Venereology (2003 – 2005 & 2007 – 2009).

Dr Chan has headed the academic division of both The University of Hong Kong (Associate Professor 2000 – 2004) and The Chinese University of Hong Kong (Associate Professor 1998 – 2000) and since 1997, he has been the Honorary Consultant Dermatologist of Hong Kong Hospital Authority. He was a visiting faculty at Harvard Medical School (Visiting Associate Professor 2008 – 2010, Visiting Scientist 2010 – 2013).

Dr Chan's work in Boston has led him to hold four patents published by the World Intellectual property organization (WO 2013/075006 A1 and WO 2013/075016 A1 and WO 2015/021462 and WO 2015/123420 A1) and these technologies have been commercially transferred by the Massachusetts General Hospital to R2 Dermatology in California and AVAVA LLC in Boston. Dr Chan has published or accepted to be published over 300 articles including 1 book, 34 book chapters and 135 peers review international indexed publications (mean impact factor 2.75). Total citation 2,761. H Index: 34 (researcher ID number: L-2267-2013). He is the Associate Editor of *Lasers in Surgery and Medicine*, and serves on the editorial board of several other international journals including the *Dermatologic Surgery*; *Lasers in Medical Science*, *Journal of Cosmetic and Laser Therapy and Skinned for Clinician*.

Dr Chan was voted and elected to membership in the American Dermatological Association as an International Honorary Member in March 2016. Dr Chan is the only non-American to be awarded the Ellet H. Drake Memorial Award by the American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery (ASLMS) for his contribution to laser surgery in 2010 and is actively involved with the Society, being the only Asian that has been session chairman for 5 ASLMS annual meetings (session chairman for the Dermatology/Plastic Surgery session in 2004, 2005 and 2014; mini-talk summaries in 2002 and international session 2013). Dr Chan has been invited to be the Conference Program Co-Chairs in 39<sup>th</sup> ASLMS Annual Conference in 2019 which will be held in Denver, USA. Dr Chan was the recipient of ASLMS Presidential Citation in 2016 and 2002. In 2012, Dr Chan becomes one of the few non-American to be elected as a member of the Board of Directors of ASLMS (2012-2015) and re-elected again in 2018 (2018-2021). He was also an elected board member of DASIL (2011-2014) and Honorary President of DASIL Annual Congress 2017. In 2014, he received the president citation from the American Society of Dermatologic Surgery.

Dr Chan has successfully defended two Doctorate theses, the first one was awarded by the King's College of The University of London (The Use of Laser in the Treatment of Naevus of Ota), the second one was awarded by the Li Ka Shing Faculty of Medicine of The University of Hong Kong (The Use of Laser and Light Source for Skin Rejuvenation in Asians).

Dr Chan has been invited as speaker at prestigious meetings including the American Dermatological Association Annual Meeting; World Congress of Dermatology; American Academy of Dermatology Annual Meeting; the American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery Annual Meeting; Japanese Society of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Annual Meeting; International Society of Dermatology Annual Meeting; International Master Course in Aging Skin and International Academy for Cosmetic Dermatology Annual Meeting. His other professional associations include Fellow and Standing Committee Member of the American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery; Fellow of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of London; the Royal Colleges of Physicians of Edinburgh and the Royal Colleges of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow; Member of the American Academy of Dermatology and American Society of Dermatologic Surgery; Fellow of Hong Kong College of Physicians and Fellow of Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (Medicine).
