

Jonathan Kantor is Medical Director, Florida Center for Dermatology, PA and Adjunct Assistant Professor of Dermatology at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania. He speaks frequently around the world on surgical techniques, skin cancer, dysplastic nevi, wound healing, and other topics, and has authored 2 books published by McGraw-Hill and more than 100 manuscripts, letters, book chapters, and abstracts. His work has been the subject of editorials in the Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology, JAMA Dermatology, the British Journal of Dermatology, and the Journal of Investigative Dermatology.

Dr. Kantor received both his BA (Phi Beta Kappa) and MA in Intellectual History from the University of Pennsylvania. While in medical school at Penn, he completed an NIH-funded fellowship in clinical epidemiology and was awarded both an MD (AOA) and a Masters of Science in Clinical Epidemiology. He then completed an internship in Internal Medicine followed by his dermatology residency, also at Penn, where he was appointed Chief Resident.

He is Associate Editor of the Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology and of Dialogues in Dermatology, and has been awarded the Member Making a Difference Award by the AAD.
