Dr. Todd E. Schlesinger is a Board Certified Dermatologist, Dermasurgeon and Cosmetic Dermatologist where he is committed to providing the highest quality professional skin care in a warm, friendly and compassionate environment.

At the State University at Buffalo School of Medicine, he was inducted into the prestigious medical honor society Alpha Omega Alpha, and received special honors in anatomy and pathology, winning entrance into the Gibson Anatomical Society and the Pathology Honor Society. Following his residency at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, Dr. Schlesinger completed additional surgical training at Scripps in La Jolla, CA, and became a Fellow of the American Society for Mohs Surgery.

He has been in private practice since 1998, and has extensive experience in all aspects of laser and light based therapies, having worked with many of these technologies since they were introduced. He founded the Clinical Research Center of the Carolinas where he is currently conducting over 25 clinical trials of new therapies and devices.

Additionally, he is a national trainer, speaker, consultant and adviser to numerous pharmaceutical, cosmetic and technology companies. Dr. Schlesinger holds academic appointments in Dermatology at the University at Buffalo and in Family Medicine at the Medical University of South Carolina, where he also serves as a preceptor in the College of Health Professions.
