

Jeremy A. Brauer, MD is an internationally recognized dermatologist with board certification and fellowship training in laser and Mohs micrographic surgery. Dr. Brauer graduated as a Merrill Presidential Scholar with Highest Distinction from Cornell University and earned his medical degree from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine.
