Dr. Claudia Marçal acquired her medical degree from the Pontifical Catholic University of Campinas in 1993, also obtaining an official monitoring certificate in dermatology in 1992/1993 and getting her medical residency and dermatology specialization in the same university from 1994 to 1996, performing ambulatory activities and supervised surgeries.

Today, she is a clinical, cosmetic and surgical dermatologist, board-certified and the founder and medical director of Espaço Cariz Dermatology clinic, offering a laser center department to treat pathologies and aesthetic disorders, a trichology department and a medical spa of excellence, in Campinas, SP, Brazil, founded in 2003. She coordinates a team composed of a physiotherapist, a nutritionist and a plastic surgeon in order to provide a thorough and personalized service.

Throughout Dr. Marçal's career she participated in and/or coordinated over thirty studies, presenting regularly some of them in national and international dermatology and cosmetic congresses. She is a member of the Brazilian Dermatology Society, Brazilian Dermatological Surgery Society, American Academy of Dermatology, IMCAS Academy, Dermatologic Aesthetic Surgery International League and American Society for Laser Medicine & Surgery. She is also a faculty speaker for IMCAS, 5 Continent Congress, DASIL, international speaker for Lumenis, L'Oreal Consultant and consultant for several other companies. A highlight in Dr. Marçal's career was in 2019, when she received a letter from the American Academy of Dermatology congratulating her for the loyalty and commitment shown and recognizing her 10 year membership.

Dr. Marçal participated in a Continuous Medical Education of Harvard Medical School and maintains herself updated by engaging in sessions, boards, conferences and congresses around the world. She frequently receives invitations to write about publicly interesting subjects for magazines and scientific articles for specialized magazines. In addition, Dr. Marçal participates in innumerable interviews for news programmes, contributing with scientific content and her personal experiences.
