Dr. Todd E. Schlesinger is a Board Certified Dermatologist, Dermasurgeon and Cosmetic Dermatologist where he is committed to providing the highest quality professional skin care in a warm, friendly and compassionate environment. He founded the Clinical Research Center of the Carolinas where he is currently conducting numerous clinical trials of new therapies and devices. Dr. Schlesinger holds academic appointments in Dermatology at the University at Buffalo and in the College of Medicine at the Medical University of South Carolina, where he also serves as a preceptor in the College of Health Professions.
