Dr. Sarah Jackson is a board-certified dermatologist who specializes in medical, cosmetic, and laser dermatology. In addition to her private practice, Dr. Jackson is an Associate Clinical Professor in the Department of Dermatology at Louisiana State University.

Dr. Jackson is a graduate of Louisiana State University School of Medicine, where she was a member of the Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Society.
