

Jonathan Kantor is editor-in-chief of *JAAD International*, the author/ editor of four textbooks published by McGraw-Hill (including the 1500-page standard textbook *Dermatologic Surgery*), and the author of over 100 peer-reviewed publications.

He is affiliated with the Department of Dermatology, Center for Global Health, and Center for Clinical Epidemiology and Biostatistics at the University of Pennsylvania Perelman School of Medicine. He is a two-time recipient of the AAD Presidential Citation Award, a recipient of the Member Making a Difference Award from the AAD, and the winner of the best paper of the year award in *Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery*. He is US board-certified in both micrographic dermatologic surgery and dermatology.

Dr Kantor's work has been the subject of editorials in every major dermatology journal. He has also been associate editor of the *Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology* and *Dialogues in Dermatology*, is on both the Mohs Appropriate Use Committee and Guidelines Committee for the AAD, and was a member of the Reconstruction after Skin Cancer Resection Guidelines Committee for the American Society of Plastic Surgeons.
